

** UEM European Junior Trial Champion 2006 **

Alexz Wigg (JST 125 Gas Gas Pro Racing) rode well to secure his third European title in the final round of this years championship at Tanval in Czechoslovakia. Finishing third on the day but only a few marks behind Loris Gubian and Alfredo Gomez, a relaxed Alexz took the title which was all but settled last weekend with his third win in the series in Poland. After nearly five weeks on the road, this was the last European Championship round, and is his 3rd UEM title to add to the two youth ones in 2004 and 2005, all 3 titles won on a JST Gas Gas 125. Gubian won on 8 marks Gomez was on twelve and a disappointed Alexz only 3rd. On 16 lost. "I didn't have a very good ride today and with a few mistakes in the 3 hard sections I wasn't that happy. But with the lead from Poland I had no pressure going into the event, and my main aim was just to get to the finish, and I am really pleased to get the UEM Junior Championship at the first try". By the time Alexz gets home it will be nearly five weeks in Europe with WTC and the European rounds.

Final Championship positions were as follows:-

1st. Alexz Wigg (JST GAS GAS) 107points,

2nd. Gubian Sherco 96

3rd. Graterola Sherco 73

4th. Gomez Gas Gas 68

NB. All provisional

Alexz is now looking forward to the next few weeks practicing and getting tuned up for WTC at Hawkstone, and back to winning ways hopefully in front of the home crowd.
