

## **REPSOL – MONTESA HRC**

World Trial Championship
11th round. Andorra Grand Prix



## Toni Bou is officially proclaimed World Champion and adds a new victory to this title.

Sant Julià de Lòria (Andorra), 02.09.2007. - Toni Bou (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) could not have celebrated his title as World Champion in a better manner than winning in Andorra this Sunday, an event which has ended the 33rd edition of the competition. Bou obtained his victory after a tough struggle with his principal rival during the entire season. The new champion's track record is impressive, with nine victories in eleven events and two second places. The result is also impressive for Montesa, bringing its record of World Championship victories to 119 and obtaining its tenth manufacturer's title, the second consecutive victory since the company decided to compete exclusively with four-stroke engines in 2005.

Takahisa Fujinami (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) obtained third place in the final thanks to his regularity, with six podium positions, and Dougie Lampkin (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) finished the championship as he had started, also obtaining a podium position. Laia Sanz (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) finished sixth in this Junior World Cup event and eighth in the final classification.

Toni Bou: "I finished the championship as I'd wanted to do from the moment I knew I was champion. It wasn't easy because Adam pushed me very hard again, but to win like this has even greater merit. It's been very exciting to receive the World Championship title. I'm going to remember this all my life".

Takahisa Fujinami: "It's been a great year for the team, although a bit less on a personal level, because to finish third in the championship is below my expectations. I'd have liked to have been on the podium today but this was the day with my worst result of the season. I'm planning to do better next year".

Dougie Lampkin: "A good result to end the season. It's a pity I couldn't repeat last year's final classification for a couple of points. Anyway, I'm satisfied with the results of the team and Toni's victory. We all worked for this goal and here we have it".

Laia Sanz: "I almost repeated my best result of the season, but the tie break was negative for me. The level of the championship has been higher than previous years and the fight tougher. I found the first half of the season difficult because of my previous injury, but I'm satisfied with these last events".
