

Outdoor Trial World Championship – Tona (Barcelona)

A Weekend Full of Success for GAS GAS

The GAS GAS rider, Adam Raga, got fourth in the penultimate round of the Outdoor Trial World Championship held in the city of Tona. This round was conclusive to clinch the title and Mr. Bou obtained the victory, followed by the riders Fujinami and Fajardo. Yesterday, Loris Gubian (GAS GAS) became European Champion. Today, Christophe Nambotin became France Enduro's Champion. No doubt about it, this weekend will definitely be a weekend to remember.

The penultimate race in this Championship had two main stars: the riders and the audience. People crowded the place to see the race. The GAS GAS rider, Adam Raga, ended up fourth and obtained 43 points throughout the two rounds.

The amount of dust in the track was also something to remember. It made the track very slippery. Zone 12 proved it, since most of the riders only got 5 points in it. Adam Raga's fourth place handed Bou the first place on a platter, and Raga now leaves Tona as the virtual Champion, only one point away from the number one spot on the podium.

"I am happy with the results. We must remember I hadn't been training for more than two months, and that was a clear disadvantage. At the end of the first round, I was penalized; and it was a pity because I could have got a place in the rostrum. I want to thank the crowd who's come to see us run today," said GAS GAS pilot, Adam Raga.

The tenth race in this World Championship, also known as *Gran Premio AMV de España de Trial*, was 8 kilometers long and had 15 different zones which the riders had to tour twice. The Outdoor Trial World Championship will come to an end next Sunday in the French site of *Isola 2000*.

Yesterday, GAS GAS rider, Loris Gubian, became European Champion. Only the competitors from the *Europeo* (Absoluto and Junior) participated and closed the 2009 season in Spain. The absolute winner was Alfredo Gómez (Montesa), from Spain, who got 16 penalization points, thus edging out Alexz Wigg (Beta) and Loris Gubian (Gas Gas).

In Enduro, Christophe Nambotin (GAS GAS) became France's Champion in the race held this weekend in Puy in Velay.
