

REPSOL – MONTESA HRC

Spanish Trial Championship 7th round.



Toni Bou wins in the last outdoor event of the year. Laia Sanz comes close to victory in Senior B and Montesa wins the championship by manufacturer.

Sant Fruitós de Bages (Barcelona), 11.11.2007. - Toni Bou (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) has won the event this Sunday that ended in Sant Fruitós de Bages the Spanish Trial Championship. The current world champion was leader in the two laps of a very difficult track, outstanding especially in the second lap. Today's has been the third victory of Toni Bou in the present edition of this championship, in which he has become sub-champion. Takahisa Fujinami (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT), who has not followed this championship, did not want to miss this last event of the open-air season, in which he finished fourth. Montesa won the championship by manufacturers.











Laia Sanz (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) was just one point away from victory in the Senior B category. The multi-champion ended the first lap in the classification and with nine points of advantage over the future winner, who in the second session benefited from a failure that has notably influenced the loss of the victory by the Montesa rider, fifth in the final general classification of this category.

Toni Bou: "Despite the fact that I don't like having lost the championship, I finished the outdoor season satisfactorily as I beat Adam in this difficult event. It's clear that next year I'll try again, and of course I expect to do better. From now on we'll concentrate on the indoor events. We still have the last events of the Spanish Championship and the beginning of the World Championship as one says, round the corner".

Laia Sanz: "I couldn't have ended the Spanish Championship better. Inevitably, to be one point from victory is disappointing, an even more so after having dominated the first lap, but nevertheless, the result has been fantastic".
